### MANDATORY RANGE OPERATION & SAFETY RULES

These mandatory Range Operation and Safety Rules have been set forth by the owners of Handgunners Inc. to make all precautions possible in the prevention of any Health Hazards, Firearm Accidents, Negligent Shootings or Death. Any Law Enforcement or Armed Security Officer that does not observe or abide these guide lines and safety rules will be dismissed from this property.

The law enforcement or armed security agency using our facility is responsible for any accidents resulting in personal injury, death or damage to the facility.

1. All officers will be under the direct supervision of the firearm instructor and range personnel.
2. You will consider a firearm loaded at all times.
3. No weapons will be loaded or unloaded inside the store or classroom area.
4. Keep your weapon in its holster and safe unless instructed otherwise while under the direct supervision of the firearm instructor or range personnel.
5. If unloading your weapon is necessary, unload your handgun or shotgun on the range inside a shooting booth with the muzzle of the weapon pointed down range in a safe direction. Keep the action of your weapon locked open. Reload weapons inside your shooting booth.
6. No loading or unloading of your magazines or weapons will be done in the walkway or on the shelf under the windows in the range. All loading and unloading will be done inside the shooting booth. Place your ammunition inside of your shooting booth on the shelf located to your left next to the control panel. Have the primers covered.
7. Keep the action open on all shotguns and the muzzle pointed in a safe direction.
8. **Do not** take a loaded weapon out of its holster to obtain information from it (model # or serial #) while inside the classroom or retail area. Go to an appropriate area or know the information prior to entering the range.
9. Ear and eye protection is mandatory for everyone to be worn inside the shooting range before the first shot is fired. "We do not supply ear and eye protection to the officers; we rent them or sell them".
10. During your course of fire keep your finger off the trigger and outside the trigger guard until you have up on target and you are aiming the weapon at the target. ON TARGET ON TRIGGER, OFF TARGET OFF TRIGGER.
11. If your weapon jams or you have some other type of problem that you can not correct **do not** come out of the shooting booth or turn around with a loaded weapon. Raise your hand and signal the firearms instructor or range personal. They will come to you and help. Keep the weapon pointed down range in a safe direction.

12. After you complete your course of fire lock the slide to the rear.
  - ✓ **HANDGUNS:** After the firearms instructor has checked your weapon for safe and clear you may holster with the action locked open indicating a safe weapon.
  - ✓ **SHOTGUNS:** Lay your shotgun down on the carpet inside the shooting booth with the action locked open and the muzzle pointed down range towards the target.
13. No one will be allowed in front of the firing line (ON THE CONCRETE RANGE FLOOR) at any time for any reason.
14. No food, drinks, opens containers, or tobacco products allowed on the range at any time.
15. Pick up fired shell casings on the carpet only, using the brooms and dustpans provided. Do not handle fired brass with your hands. Place the fired cases into the fired brass containers located on each end of the range. Not the trash cans.
16. Do not sweep any fired shell casings from the concrete floor onto the carpet. This will contaminate the area in which you lay shooting prone.
17. Place used targets into the trash can.
18. After completion of your firearms qualifications reload your weapon and holster at the instruction of the Firearms Instructor or Range Officer.
19. Wash your hands when you have completed firing and you come off the range.
20. **NOTICE!** – If you are unable to keep your fired rounds within your target, you will be dismissed from the firing line. Any damages incurred to the range through your negligence will be billed to your agency. **You Shoot It – You Buy It!**

## OPERATION OF TARGETS FROM MAIN CONTROL PANEL WHEN NEEDED.

1. All targets will be operated and the course of fire will be called from the master control panel.
2. The officers will put their target in place on the cardboard. Place their name and **DF** (for day fire) or **NF** (for night fire) or **SG** (for shotgun) in the top right of their target along with a numeric indicator for qualification round (i.e. DF-1 for 1st day qualification; NF-2 for 2<sup>nd</sup> night qualification).
3. After the completion of the course of fire, targets, officers will be instructed to take their targets down or leave them in place to be scored by the instructor. Officers will hang a new target as soon as possible.
4. Officers will load their magazines only, not their weapons while targets are being scored inside their shooting positions. **DO NOT HANDLE YOUR WEAPON.**  
The command will be given to chamber a live round, pointing the weapon down range and holster at the beginning of the next relay.

ANYONE THAT DOES NOT IS OBSERVED OR ABIDES BY THESE GUIDE LINES AND SAFETY RULES JEOPARDIZING THE SAFETY OR THE LIVES OF OTHERS WILL BE DISMISSED FROM THIS PROPERTY.
